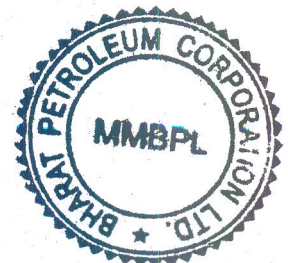

2. C Petroleum products availability position:

BPCL have a 12 MMTPA refinery at Mumbai. We have in operation Mumbai – Manmad – Manglya – Piyala Bijwasan Pipeline since March 1998. The designed capacity of this pipeline is 6 MMTPA. It caters to six states viz., Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and Delhi. The throughput of this pipeline during 2010- 11 was 6.145 MMTPA this is estimated to be 6.3 MMTPA in 2011-12.

Bharat Oman Refineries Ltd, a BPCL joint venture with Oman Oil Company Ltd has set up a 6 MMTPA refinery at Bina. The evacuation of product is through Bina – Kota pipeline. The designed capacity is 2.8 MMTPA. This pipeline joins the Mumbai Manmad – Bijwasan pipeline at Kota.

The proposed Kota Jobner 14” pipeline has its origin at Kota terminal which gets connected to the above existing pipeline. Thus product availability is assured for this pipeline.
