Public Notice No: PNGRB/Auth/3-PPPL(01)/2025

Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL) has proposed to develop three petroleum and petroleum products pipelines from its Mumbai Refinery to its upcoming storage facilities and terminals at Rasayani. In this regard, BPCL informed PNGRB that they are developing Petroleum Product Storage, Base Oil Storage and blending facilities at Rasayani as a strategic extension of Mumbai Refinery. Additionally, in light of safety and security considerations, BPCL has proposed the relocation of its existing Sewree Terminal to Rasayani. This new facility is envisioned to function as an extended storage facility for Mumbai Refinery while simultaneously serving as a key marketing terminal for the efficient evacuation of refinery products.

Furthermore, BPCL has underscored that the proposed three pipelines linking the Mumbai Refinery to Rasayani are integral to the refinery's operations, playing a pivotal role in debottlenecking processes and optimizing overall efficiency. Given the significance of this infrastructure in optimizing logistical and operational processes, BPCL vide letter dated 15.07.2024 (attached with this Public Notice) has formally requested PNGRB to address this matter in accordance with Regulation 19 of the PNGRB's PPPL Authorization Regulations.

2. In light of the above, PNGRB is processing these three pipelines as dedicated pipelines under Regulation 19(2) of the PNGRB (Authorizing Entities to Lay, Build, Operate, or Expand Petroleum and Petroleum Products Pipelines) Regulations, 2010.

The details of the proposed pipelines as submitted by BPCL are mentioned herewith: -

BPCL has proposed total three pipelines i.e. two pipelines which BPCL is planning to lay from their Mumbai refinery to upcoming marketing terminal at Rasayani and another pipeline which BPCL plans to lay in future based on the refinery expansion to meet petroleum product demand supply situation.

In terms of the provisions of Regulation 19(2) of PNGRB (Authorizing Entities to Lay, Build, Operate or Expand Petroleum and Petroleum Products Pipelines) Regulations, 2010, PNGRB seeks comments of general public with a view to ascertain whether, instead of a dedicated pipeline, the public interest would be better served if a petroleum and petroleum products pipeline is laid, built, operated or expanded.
