The Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) has received an application from GAIL Mangalore Petrochemicals Limited (GMPL) under Regulation 19(2) of the PNGRB (Authorizing Entities to Lay, Build, Operate or Expand Petroleum and Petroleum Products Pipelines) Regulations, 2010 to develop a dedicated pipeline for transportation of Paraxylene from New Mangalore Port to GMPL's PTA Plant.

The details of the proposed pipeline as submitted by GMPL are mentioned herewith: -
