Public Notice

Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) has received an application from M/s Asian Paints (Polymers) Private Limited (APPPL) for laying, building and operating a dedicated gaseous ethylene pipeline under Regulation 19(2) of the PNGRB (Authorizing Entities to Lay, Build, Operate or Expand Natural Gas Pipelines) Regulations, 2008.

The details of the aforesaid dedicated pipelines as submitted by APPPL is given below: -

Particulars	Details
Nature of pipeline:	Dedicated underground pipeline exclusively for supply of gaseous ethylene to APPPL for self consumption
Primary source:	Gujarat Chemical Port Limited (GCPL)
Alternate/interim source:	ONGC Petro Additions Limited (OPaL)
Diameter and length:	Main pipeline from GCPL to APPPL: 8-inch diameter, approximately 13 km. Interim connectivity from OPaL: 8-inch diameter, approximately 4 km, connecting to the main pipeline.
Pipe specifications:	API 5L Grade B, PSL 1; Schedule STD; Seamless pipes with beveled ends; external coating of 3LPE
Design and operating parameters:	Design pressure up to 38 bar (g); design temperature from -29°C to +65°C; maximum flow rate of 14 MT/hour
Design standards:	The pipeline has been designed in accordance with applicable OISD guidelines and relevant engineering codes

In terms of the provisions of Regulation 19(2) of the above said Regulations, PNGRB seeks comments of general public with a view to ascertain whether such pipelines needs to be converted into natural gas pipelines in public interest.
