Dear Madam,

At the outset, AGP CGD India Private Limited wishes for the safety of you and your team amidst the outbreak of pandemic.

We write to you in context to the above referred public notice as webhosted by the Honorable Board w.r.t. the Expression of interest ("Eoi") from GSPL India Gasnet Limited ("GIGL") for laying a spur line Dwecha, Jalore (SV-01 station on Barmer - Pali Pipeline) to HPCL Rajasthan Refinery Limited (HRRL) at Pachpadra, Barmer (Rajasthan) in terms of Regulation 21 (3) of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Authorizing Entities to Lay, Build, Operate or Expand Natural Gas Pipelines) Regulations, 2008. AG&P sincerely lauds and welcomes the public consultation process for the proposed Eoi for overall development of natural gas availability for city gas distribution networks in the region, thus, facilitating the faster access to clean fuel for the citizens in this part of the country.

AG&P places on record, the importance of the proposed spurline which would be beneficial for us to expedite the supply of natural gas to the demand centers in and around Pachpadra and Siwana Charge Areas of Barmer District. We support laying of this spur pipeline.

In addition to the above, AG&P would like to submit without prejudice to our earlier submissions, in context to the approved pipeline sections and spur-line of the Mehsana Bathinda Natural Gas Pipeline (MBPL), that AG&P had considered the pipeline and associated spur-line of MBPL prevailing at the time of bid for evaluation and submissions thereon for the GA of Barmer, Jodhpur and Jaisalmer Districts. We have observed that though, the map vide Annexure-A of the Eoi shows part section

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of the proposed connectivity of Barmer-Pali-Jodhpur Pipeline section of MBPL, i.e. from SV-01 to HRRL at Pachpadra, however, it does not depict the Pali-Jodhpur section on the GIGL's under construction pipeline.

AG&P is developing its infrastructure in Jodhpur taking into consideration the Pali-Jodhpur spurline section which was depicted in the original map would be commissioned in the near future. The pipeline infrastructure thereafter shall be integrated with our virtual pipeline based infrastructure for Jodhpur District.

AG&P would like to emphasize on the necessity for a natural gas source in the form of trunk line connectivity in Jodhpur District for ensuring faster roll out to the domestic and transport segments in the public interest for the development of natural gas infrastructure.
