

**NOTIFICATION**  
**THE PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS REGULATORY BOARD**

F. No. -----, - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 61 of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board Act, 2006 (Act 19 of 2006), the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board hereby makes the following regulations, namely: –

1. **Short title and commencement: -**

(1) These regulations may be called the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Authorizing Entities to Lay, Build, Operate or Expand City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Networks) Amendment Regulations, 2008.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Authorizing Entities to Lay, Build, Operate or Expand City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Networks) Regulations, 2008.

(a) in regulation 3 (2) (a), the following shall be added after the proviso (i.e..... *for the CGD Network*): -

**“Such customers are required to apply for Permission of the Board, in writing as per the format given in Schedule-L”**

(b) Schedule-L as given below shall be inserted after Schedule – K: -

**Note: Copy of Agreement/ MoU/term sheet/GTA/ GSA between Consumer and seller must have a mandatory clause that once CGD Network is ready to supply natural gas to such industrial/ commercial consumer, then such customer shall cease to get supply of natural gas from such alternate source or supplier after 30 days of receipt of notice of readiness from the CGD network.”**
