Sub : Expression of Interest (EOI) to Lay, Build & Operate Petroleum Product (LPG) Pipeline from Haldia to Panagarh (West Bengal) under Regulation 4(1).

Respected Ma'am,

HPCL LPG demand for West Bengal, Bihar, Jharkhand markets are currently being met through Import at Haldia. The onward movement of LPG from Haldia to HPCL Bottling plants are by road.

We propose to lay a new LPG petroleum product pipeline from Haldia port to our existing LPG bottling plant at Panagarh in West Bengal with a provision for future extension to Paharpur LPG Plant. The LPG pipeline is safe, environment friendly & most economical mode for transportation of LPG from Haldia compared to existing road transportation.

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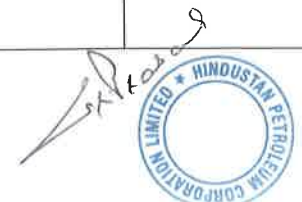


