2. Basic Data

A. 1) Population and number of households under the proposed CGD network.

The population in the proposed GA (Port Blair) is around 1,56,896 as per census of India, 2011 with an estimated number of households of 39,042 (including Urban & rural).

(NVVN) intends to setup a 50 MW gas based power plant in Hope Town in South Andaman of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands (A&N) and plan to appoint a gas supplier for the same. The location of the power plant and the Gas infrastructure has been finalized at Hope Town in South Andaman by the Government of A&N. PLL proposed to set up a FSRU to regassify LNG to supply Gas to the Power Plant, this would be the source for the of supply of Gas to CGD network at Port Blair. Gas shall be sourced from long term or Spot LNG market by PLL.
