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Dear Sir,

For common carrier capacity at LNG terminal, what will be the tariff/charges user require to pay LNG terminal operator? Will PNGRB regulate the tariff/charges on common carrier capacity of LNG terminal? - Our view is that PNGRB should not regulate those charges but LNG operators should not charge excess to users. Charges on common carries should be higher than long term contracted capacity but with certain cap as (10% or 20% higher than long term contracted charges) may be fit with regulator. There should be flexibility to LNG operators to lower the charges in lean season.

Will LNG operators publish charges/tariff on common carrier capacity on their website? - To be fair & transparent to users, LNG operators must publish charges on common carrier capacity.
