We would like to introduce ourselves as one of the No.1 Tile manufacturing company in India having Multi-layer manufacturing facilities across India. One of our plant is situated at Vill. Gailpur, Alwar Distt. (Rajasthan). We are a dedicated user of this green fuel natural gas / RLNG.

RLNG/NG forms a major share of our input cost. We are consuming NG/RLNG being supplied through HVJ/CJHPL pipeline, however, being located far away from Dahej, we are at a disadvantage in comparison with our competitors situated in the Western Region as we have to pay multiple pipeline tariffs.

The Ceramic industry is facing several issues and it is fighting for its survival hence it is imperative to keep our product very competitive to survive.
