

**Open House discussion on Public Consultation Document for determination of Final Tariff**

1. Open House (“OH”) on the public consultation document (“PCD”) for determination of final tariff of HVJ and HVJ Upgradation was held on 26.11.2018. Open house was chaired by Chairperson, wherein other Board members viz. Member (C&M), Member (Legal) and Member (I&T) were also present. List of other participants is attached.
2. During the OH, GAIL explained their response through a presentation, on issues raised by various stakeholders. Presentation made by GAIL is attached as **Annexure-1**.
3. Other points raised/discussed are as follows:
  - 3.1.**EWPL**
    - 3.1.1.EWPL made the comment that as per current tariff regulations, volume divisor considered is normative or actual, whichever is higher. Similarly, fuel consumption should also be considered based on the volume considered in calculating the tariff instead of actuals.

## **3.2.GSPL**

3.2.1.The comment on extending economic life of HVJ by 10 years i.e. upto 2032 raised by GSPL was not covered in the presentation given by GAIL. PNGRB expressed its annoyance for not including this issue in the presentation. The comments submitted by GAIL.

## **3.3.PNGRB**

3.3.1.PNGRB observed that comments may be sought from the stakeholders on determination of tariff considering the HVJ and HVJ Upgradation as integrated pipeline or separately. In this regard, PNGRB asked GAIL to submit its inputs by 27.11.2018. On receipt of inputs from GAIL, PNGRB will seek public comments on whether the final tariff of the HVJ and HVJ Upgradation be determined as an integrated system or separately as before. In addition, GAIL was asked to explain how capacity utilization is determined for the two pipelines.

3.3.2.PNGRB asked GAIL to submit the updated list of the spurlines laid for HVJ and HVJ Upgradation by 29.11.2018.

3.3.3.PNGRB asked GAIL to submit its detailed response on GSPL's comments for extending economic life of HVJ by another 10 years i.e. upto 2032. GAIL sought two weeks time for submission of its comments.

3.3.4.PNGRB also asked GAIL's views by 29.11.2018 regarding the consideration of economic life of pipeline as 30 years as against current consideration of economic life as 25 years.

3.3.5.GAIL in its presentation stated that the Capex considered on account of Rich lean gas corridor is due to present modification being done for improving the operational flexibility and efficiency of the pipeline

system. In this regard, PNGRB asked GAIL to submit a detailed explanation by 29.11.2018, as to why this capex should be considered for tariff fixation.

4. At the end of the OH, stakeholders were asked to submit their further comments, if any, by 29.11.2018.
5. Meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
