

Subject	Open House Discussion on Draft Amendment in Natural Gas Pipeline Regulations webhosted on 29-09-2020 – Unified Tariff
Date & Time of Open House	23 rd October, 2020 & 11:00 Hrs

1. PNGRB has received 105 comments from different types of stakeholders like Ministry of Fertilizers, Natural Gas Pipelines Entities, LNG Companies, E&P Companies, Gas Marketing Companies, Lawyers, different types of Consumers like Fertilizer Companies, Power Sector Companies, CGD Companies and others, etc.
2. All the stakeholders which have either given their comments or requested for participations in the Open House were sent the invitation to attend the same through video conference. The Open House discussion was chaired by Chairperson, PNGRB and attended by Member, Secretary and other officials from PNGRB. List of participants is attached as **Annexure I**.
3. During the open house, Chairperson welcomed all the stakeholders and appreciated that various categories of stakeholders submitted their comments and also participating in the Open House. In order to streamline the discussion, Chairperson categorised the participants in various groups for the purpose of conducting the Open House. An opportunity was given to all the categories of participants starting with the NGPL entities, LNG Companies, E&P companies, Gas Marketers, Fertiliser Consumers, Power consumers and so on to express their views. Mostly participants reiterated the written comments which they have already submitted. The said comments have already been webhosted on PNGRB's website.
4. Chairperson also mentioned in the meeting that based on discussions in the Open House, if any participants still feels that they want to submit any further comments, they may do so in the next few days. Chairperson also asked FAI to submit fertiliser plant wise gas consumption and estimated additional burden, if any due to implementation of the proposed unified tariff.
5. In the end, Chairperson thanked the participants for their extensive discussion which lasted for around three hours and while concluding OH mentioned that comments

submitted will suitably be addressed while framing the Regulations as the Board is mandated to protect the interest of the consumers and the entities.
