PUBLIC NOTICE

The Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board has received an application from Kailash Energy Solution under Regulation 19(2) of the PNGRB (Authorizing Entities to Lay, Build, Operate or Expand Natural Gas Pipeline) Regulations, 2008, submitting information for its proposed Dedicated Pipelines between ONGC's Padra Well 149 and 93 in Gujarat and their plant at S. No. 1076/77, Village Amla, Padra, Vadodara, Gujarat 391 440.
