## PUBLIC NOTICE

PNGRB proposes to develop a Natural Gas pipeline to cater to the requirement of Natural Gas in the states of Andhra Pradesh/Telangana/Karnataka/Maharashtra. Hence, it has been decided to initiate suo-motu proposal for development of Natural Gas pipeline originating from Ennore and terminating at either Padur (Rangareddy district) in Telangana or at Barshi (Solapur district) in Maharashtra under Regulation 4(2) read with Regulation 6 of PNGRB NGPL Authorization Regulations. The pipeline will emanate from Ennore LNG Terminal, Ennore and connects to East-West pipeline either at Pudur (CS-04) or Barshi (CS-06) so that the gas can be transported to major interconnecting pipelines in the country. The following options has been proposed (An indicative route map is attached as **Annexure-A**):

	<b>Proposed Pipeline</b>	<b>States covered</b>	<b>Length (Approx)</b>
<b>Option 1</b>	Ennore to Padur	Andhra Pradesh and Telangana	630 km.
<b>Option 2</b>	Ennore to Barshi	Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka and Maharashtra	875 km.

Based on views/comments of the entities, one of the most optimal route will be selected for invitation of bids. Accordingly, in terms of Regulation 5(1) of PNGRB NGPL Authorization Regulations, the Board announces the commencement of the public consultation process. In this regard, views/comments in writing from any person or stakeholders/entity are invited within 30 days of publication of this public notice on the PNGRB website. The suggestions/comments of stakeholders/entity are also invited on the originating point, terminating point, pipeline route and minimum capacity for the proposed Natural Gas pipeline as mentioned above.

In this regard, the views/comments received from various entities/stakeholders will be webhosted at PNGRB's website for information to the public. Further, an open house discussion with stakeholders/entities, who have offered views/comments will be held later on with the entities/stakeholders for which intimation will be communicated separately.
