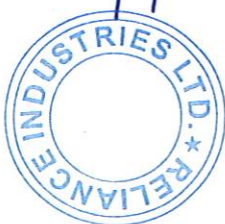

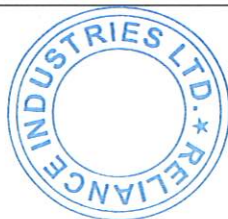

a)	Petroleum Product (ATF) pipeline proposed	<p>New ATF pipeline proposed from MRPL Devangonhi Terminal to Bangalore Airport Fuel Farm at Kempegowda International Airport, Bengaluru – 36 Km.</p> <p>ATF volumes at Kempegowda International Airport, Bengaluru is seeing increasing growth post commencement of flight operations from Terminal T-2 of the Airport.</p> <p>IOCL Devangonhi-Devanahalli (DDPL) common carrier ATF pipeline (capacity: 0.66 MMTPA) does not have any spare capacity.</p> <p>Common carrier access to third parties is currently not available in DDPL to private Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs).</p> <p>Proposed new ATF pipeline will provide relief to OMCs denied access in DDPL and</p>





		<p>benefit stakeholders in the following manner.</p> <p>The proposed pipeline will cater to the future ATF demand increase at Bengaluru Airport and benefit all stakeholders including air passengers by fostering competitiveness within the industry.</p> <p>The proposed ATF pipeline while reducing ATF procurement cost for the airlines will ensure supply security and operational reliability for placement of ATF.</p> <p>The proposed pipeline will reduce carbon emission of road transportation (part of ATF demand is currently met through tank trucks).</p>
b)	Other aspects of the proposal	<p>Bangalore Airport Fuel Farm at Kempegowda International Airport has open access.</p> <p>To facilitate use of the new pipeline, MRPL Devengunthi terminal receipt & storage facilities may be brought under the scope of the common carrier notification so that non-discriminatory and transparent access is available to all interested suppliers of ATF on common carrier basis on terms and conditions in a transparent manner.</p>
c)	Any other issue	<p>No additional charges may be levied for usage of storage or receipt facilities at MRPL Devangonhi Terminal apart from the pipeline tariff fixed by PNGRB.</p>
