Saint-Gobain India Pvt Ltd, is part of Saint-Gobain group of companies established in the year 1665 In France. Saint Gobain currently operates from 68 countries with an annual turnover of over 40 billion Euros. Saint-Gobain's Brand is widely recognised and respected in India with PAN India presence, having manufacturing sites in 22 sites across India.

One of the of 5 float glass manufacturing plants of Saint Gobain India Pvt Ltd., Is located at Bhiwadi, Rajasthan in the Delhi NCR Region. 100% of our furnace energy requirement for this plant is being met by using the green fuel, Natural gas (NG).

The energy cost (NG cost) forms major form of our glass manufacturing cost. Since we are geographically located far away from Dahej/Hazira from where the NG supplies come from, we are at disadvantage of paying transmission charges for multiple pipe lines vis-à-vis our competitors whose manufacturing plants are located in western region of India closer to Dahej/Hazira. The glass industry as such is also badly impacted by current economic downturn scenarios, slowdown of automotive sector and several other factors.


Currently the NG supplies to our Bhiwadi plant is being supplied through two pipelines viz. HVJ and CJHPL. With the view of optimizing the tariff costs currently being incurred by us, we hereby request your good office to combine the above pipelines into one pipe line thereby help us in reduction of the overall cost of transmission tariff.

We look forward for a positive reply in this regard.
