Respected Ma'am,

With reference to the public notice web hosted by PNGRB seeking comments on the application made by M/s Auraglass Pvt. Ltd. (AGPL) to lay build and operate a dedicated natural gas pipeline from ONGC GGS Jambusar, Gujarat to Auraglass Pvt. Ltd. (AGPL), Uchchhad, Gujarat under regulation 19(2) of PNGRB (Authorizing Entities to Lay, Build, Operate or Expand Natural Gas Pipelines) Regulations, 2008, we submit our views as below:

- This is a good initiative by Hon'ble PNGRB under the aegis of MoPNG (Govt. of India) for utilization of gas extracted from “small and isolated gas fields”. This will help ONGC to extract and sell gas from its low producing fields and monetize it.
- Such step to offer natural gas from isolated and small natural gas fields is highly appreciative especially during the time when Govt. of India is seeking to make Indian economy a gas-based economy.
- This will also, help winner industries to replace the costly as well as polluting fuel by the cheaper & environment friendly Natural Gas.
- If the gas from the field allocated to AGPL is being used for self-consumption and not for (selling to others, as AGPL is situated in the authorized area of Gujarat Gas Ltd.) then this is good step and NOC shall be given for pipeline construction.

In context of above mentioned points, I would like to place my view on record for the progressive step of Hon'ble PNGRB, MoPNG & Govt. India and recommend to grant the NOC to ACPL for dedicated natural gas pipeline from ONGC GGS Jambusar, Gujarat to Auraglass Pvt. Ltd. (AGPL), Uchchhad, Gujarat under regulation 19(2) of PNGRB (Authorizing Entities to Lay, Build, Operate or Expand Natural Gas Pipelines) Regulations, 2008.

We trust the Hon'ble board finds our observations / views useful for the development of the robust downstream infrastructure to ultimately increase the consumption of Natural Gas in the India's energy basket.
