Ref: PNGRB/COM/2-NGPL/Tariff (3)/2019 Vol-II Dated 29.04.2020.

With respect to the above, we are submitting our comments on the proposed draft amendment provided in Annexure-1 and options provided in Annexure-2

1. The amendments proposed vide 2 (d) & (e) of annexure 1 will prima facie lead to increase in tariff as the value of the divisors are being reduced. It may please be noted that we have already sought reduction in tariff charges vide letter CMD-CO-G2-045 dt. 23.05.2020 from our CMD to the Chairman of PNGRB, Shri D. K. Sarraf.

2. The proposed amendment vide clause 2 (h) 1 (b) of Annexure 1 should be modified to provide reduced tarrif to consumers utilising only a short portion of say up to 30 kms of the pipeline . FACT is paying huge tariff charges for utilizing 25 km pipeline from PLL terminal at Cochin to FACT Udyogamandal plant. This is cross –subsidization and is ultra-vires.
3. The annual increase proposed vide clause 2 (i) of Annexure- 1 is not acceptable.
4. With respect to annexure- 2,clause C, the existing clause in the Regulation may please be retained as such without any amendment and the set of period limited to 5 years as at present. Otherwise the tariff charges will escalate further.”
