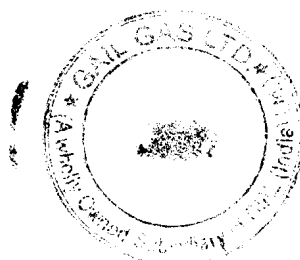
Application form for submitting expression of interest by an entity desirous of laying, building, operating or expanding a CGD network
