Population and number of households under the proposed CGD network.</b> The population of the proposed geographical area as per census 2001 stood at 5.2 Lakhs with an estimated 1.1 lakh households.</p> <p><b>2. Geographical area in square kilometers and segregated in different categories in terms of the provisions under regulation 2 (c) of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (Authorizing Entities to Lay, Build, Operate or Expand City or Local Natural Gas Distribution Networks) Regulations, 2008.</b> <b>The area should also be depicted in a physical map.</b> The proposed network shall cater to the geographical areas consisting of Anjar, Bhuj, Bacchau, Gandhidham and surrounding contiguous areas where there is major industrial activity. <b>Proposed Geographical area is of approximately 1011 sq. km.</b> The proposed area is depicted in physical map attached as <b>Annexure I</b></p> <p><b>3. Economic activity in the proposed geographical area in terms of industrial and commercial activity (number of units and fuel mix)</b> Kachch is one of evolving industrial hub of Gujarat and houses two major ports namely Mundra and Kandla. In and around the cities of Anjar, Bhuj, Bacchau, Gandhidham, there are few large capital intensive industries (Pipelines, Cement, Chemicals etc.) and around 3500 small &amp; medium scale industries. In the small</p>



	<p>scale sector Paper, Warehousing, timber and Salt processing industry dominate. The various types of fuel used in the industry are FO, LDO, LPG, Wood, Coal, Bio-mass etc. With rapid urbanization, commercialization and population growth due to migration of industrial workers from various parts of the country a number of hotels, hospitals, hostels, bakeries, lodges, sweet shops, super markets, and cinema theatres have come up in the city. The number of commercial establishments in the city is close to 1000. Most of the units use LPG for cooking. Kachch falls under seismic zone 5.</p> <p><b>4. <b>B</b>	<p><b>Preliminary Assessment of the potential demand for natural gas in the proposed CGD network amongst various Customer segments.</b></p> <p>Estimated demand of the CGD network is 0.26 MMSCMD and is projected to be 1.16 MMSCMD by year 2025. 	<p>time as prescribed in regulations notified by PNGRB.</p> <p><b>Access to transmission Pipelines:</b></p> <p>Gujarat State Petronet Limited ("GSPL") is building a high pressure transmission pipeline starting from Morbi and passing through above mentioned areas and terminating at Mundra. The pipeline is expected to be completed and commissioned by Q3 of year 2009. This pipeline shall act as backbone for supply of natural gas to various consumers along the route including the City Gas Distribution Projects. GGCL proposes to feed the City Gas network for Kachch area from GSPL pipeline. Thus with established sources of gas and tie up with transmission system to transport gas from source to City Gate Station, GGCL shall be in position to meet the gas requirements for the distribution of natural gas within Kachch Geographical Area.</p>
D	<p><b>Whether the states or the Union Territories, in whose jurisdiction the proposed CGD network is located, has enacted any legislation or taken any administrative action to promote the use of natural gas in the said city? If the reply to the question is yes, then provide copy of the said enactment or administrative order.</b></p> <p>Government of Gujarat had earlier enacted <b>Gujarat Gas Act, 2001</b> for the development of Gas Sector in the state and subsequently issued Interim Policy on Gas Distribution to promote the development of CGD Networks in the state. However Supreme Court of India has ruled that the said act is ultra vires the constitution and hence is void.</p>
