We are pleased to submit our application under regulation 19(2) for laying building and operating the proposed dedicated natural gas pipeline from ONGC Banskandi EPS to Ladi Steel Industries Pvt Ltd at Doyapore, Silchar, Assam.

This line is proposed to evacuate natural gas from Ex-Banskandi-EPS (Banskandi isolated field), which was allotted to our company by ONGC with a capacity of 36500 Scmd+/- 10% at a pressure of 10 bar. 2. ONGC has awarded the gas from Banskandi field, Silchar, Assam to our company KEI-RSOS Petroleum and Energy Ltd. The gas will be further processed and delivered at Ex-Banskandi-EPS, Cachar Forward Base, A&AA Basin, Silchar, Assam
3. This dedicated pipeline will be used to deliver gas to Ladi Steel Industries Pvt Ltd Industries, Doyapore, Silchar, Assam and other tea estates along the route.
4. ONGC allocation from Banskandi field is 36,500 SCMD +/- 10% for a period of 10 years and expected to increase further upto 60000 within the next 3 years.

Detailed Feasibility Report

KEI-RSOS Petroleum & Energy Pvt Ltd is a focused Oil & Gas exploration and production company and currently operates 5 marginal fields, 5 isolated fields and 2 DSF fields in KG basin, Cauvery basin and Assam. We have carried out extensive well workover operations in the marginal onshore fields. The company has commissioned a gas processing facility and Gas collecting station with a capacity to process 4,00,000 Scmd of Gas. We are currently producing 50,000 scmd of gas and supplying it to M/s RAK ceramics.

KRPEL has got gas allocation from Banaskandi field of ONGC, Silchar, Assam for a quantity of 36500 SCMD +/- 10% for a period of ten years. This allocation is under the direct marketing of isolated and marginal fields of ONGC. We are intending to supply this gas to M/s Ladi steel Industries located at Doyapore, Silchar and the nearby tea estates, where the gas is required for captive power generation and internal consumption. The unit is located at a distance of 14 km from this ONGC Banskandi EPS. Hence, KRPEL proposes to lay a 4" dia 14 km length gas pipeline to connect the ONGC Banskandi EPS to Ladi steel Industries and other tea estates enroute.

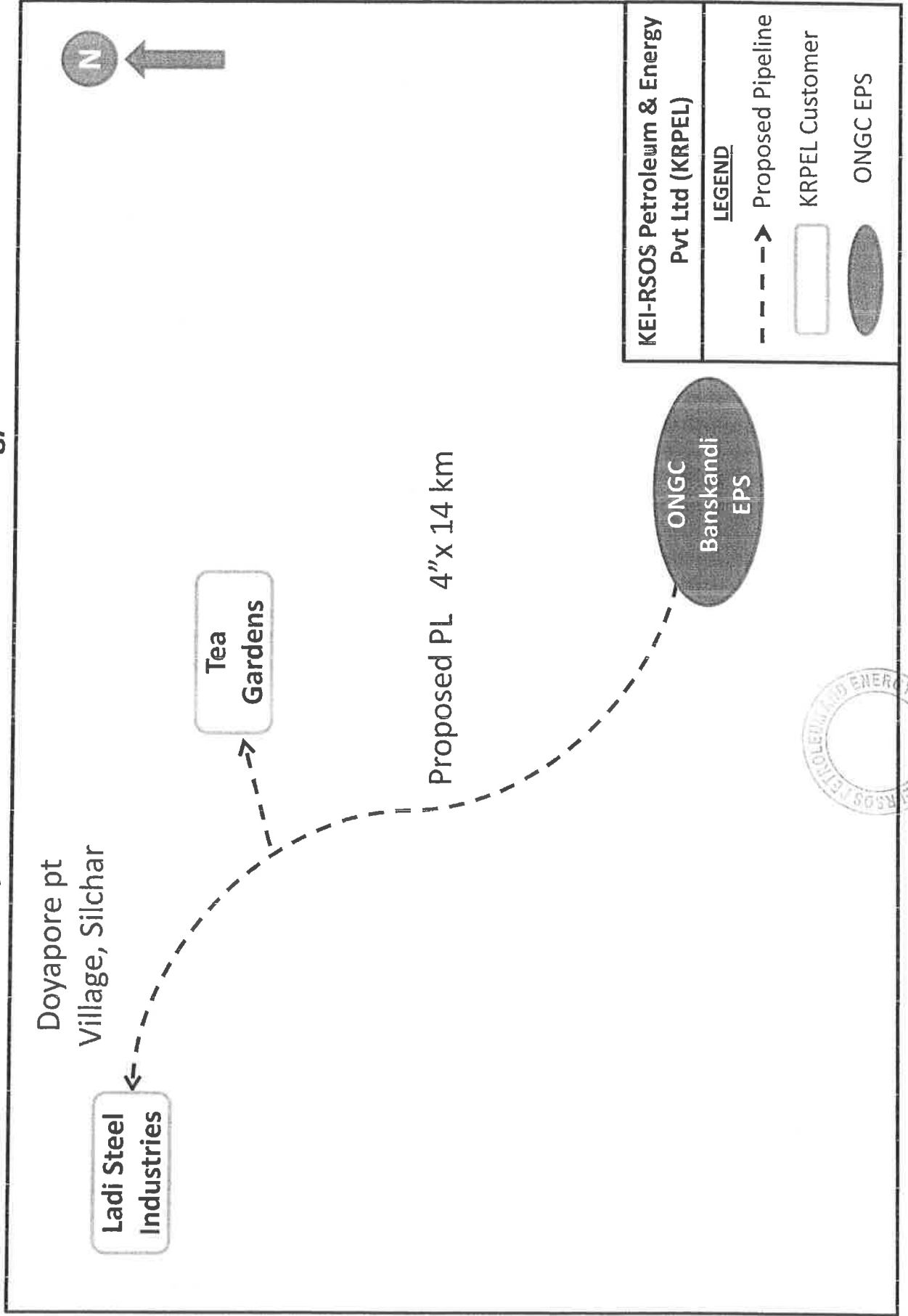



This is with reference to ONGC's Tender No. S24AC16009 for sale of 37,500 SCMD gas from Banaskandi field of Cachar Forward Base, A&AA Basin, Silchar to be delivered ex-Banaskandi EPS, your bid response No. 650054717 submitted through ONGC's e-bidding portal for sourcing 37,500 SCMD gas.

I am directed to inform that your bid is accepted by ONGC and 37,500 (Thirty Seven thousand Five hundred) SCMD gas has been allocated in terms of Article 4.4 of BEC provided in Annexure-III of tender document. The gas supplies will be on 'fall-back' and 'as is where is' basis from ONGC's Banaskandi field of Cachar Forward Base, A&AA Basin at prevailing domestic gas price on GCV basis notified by Govt. of India from time to time plus a premium of

The domestic gas price notified by Govt. of India for the period Apr'17 to Sep'17 is USD 2.48/MMBTU (on GCV basis), therefore, present applicable gas price is _____ on GCV basis, which will be revised as & when revised domestic gas price is notified.

The above price is exclusive of VAT and all other applicable taxes on sale of gas as specified in the tender document. The marketing margin of ₹ 200/MSCM-(Rupees two hundred only per MSCM) on NCV basis would be charged in addition to the gas price.

With reference to the above mentioned letter, we are hereby submitting the clarifications for each of the points mentioned in your letter as below:

1. It is informed that the intent of laying a natural gas pipeline (from ONGC's Banskandi-EPS field to Ladi Steel Industries Pvt. Lt 's premises) is to supply natural gas to three different customers viz Ladi steel Industries Pvt. Ltd., Cachar Ispat Pvt. Ltd and Cachar Alloys situated in the same premises. Though all the three customers belong to the same group and are sister companies, they will have to be treated separately. In view of the above, KRPEL should justify how should the above pipeline be treated as dedicated in nature with respect to regulation 2(1) & 19(2) of PNGRB (Authorizing entities to lay, build, operate or expand natural Gas pipelines) Regulations, 2008.

Ans: The gas will be supplied only to a single customer namely Cachar Alloys Pvt Ltd

2. M/S. KRPEL should confirm whether the gas will be supplied to a single specific customer or multiple customers.

Ans: KRPEL will supply gas to a single specific customer.

3. If it is a single customer then documentary evidence in support of agreement between the customer and the Supplier/ transporter / shipper for supply of natural gas is to be submitted

Ans: Cachar alloys has approached our company expressing their desire to procure natural gas from KRPEL. Attached pse find the letter. Currently commercial negotiations are underway with Cachar alloys and hence it may not be possible to provide the documentary evidence like a gas sales agreement etc. This will be forwarded as soon as we enter into the same.



With reference to the above mentioned letter, we are hereby submitting the clarifications for each of the points mentioned in your letter as below:

Q1. The above information submitted by the M/s. KRPEPL may be explained in detail.

Ans: Sir, In the initial stages, we had planned to set up small natural gas based power plant captive for cachar industries, however now we have shelved the plan because during our initial negotiations, the gas was to be supplied to both the customers which belong to the same industrial group. However during subsequent negotiations, the customer decided that they only require for one unit only, namely M/s Cachar Alloys Pvt Ltd. Hence, the gas will only be supplied to a single customer via this pipeline namely M/s Cachar Alloys Pvt Ltd.

Ans: KRPEPL once again confirms that the gas will only be supplied to a single customer via this pipeline namely M/s Cachar Alloys Pvt Ltd.


Q3. Copy of firm agreement between M/s. KRPEPL and M/s Cachar Alloys Pvt Ltd for supply of natural gas in support of (b)
